He lives and works in London and Tokyo



His paintings are populated by quirky figures—at the hairdressers, in the playground, on the football pitch, around a boardroom table, in the classroom, at a bank of monitors, in a stretch limo, as well as engaging in other activities that reflect the contemporary world of work and leisure. Some scenarios extend to more exotic activities surfing, skiing, or bidding in an auction—while a few, such as riding in a spaceship or taking off in a rocket, are even more fanciful. The enlarged, irregularly-shaped heads of these characters represent the psychological space—a zone of dreams, ideas, concerns and desires—that each of us, especially in a hospital setting, carries with us.
